


Before you start the **ASPIRE** processes looking for information and while you look for info you <u>must</u> have <u>open</u> interesting questions.

What new questions


Which info is important and relevant?










If you are planning on making, creating or testing, is there an expert you need to speak to or is there a particular skill you need?


